Mike frequently represents inventors, technology companies, and other businesses in disputes involving patent infringement, trade secret claims and other business torts in the Northern and Eastern Districts of Texas, Delaware, and numerous other state and federal courts. Mike handles cases regarding a wide range of technologies and technical issues, including pharmaceuticals (Hatch Waxman litigation), consumer electronics, wireless communication devices/systems, semiconductors, software, commercial construction and design, manufacturing equipment and systems, and power and electrical distribution systems. In 2021, Mike was trial counsel for the plaintiff in *ams sensors USA Inc. v. Renesas Electronics America Inc.*, a case involving breach of contract and trade secret misappropriation claims. The jury returned an \$86 million verdict.

In addition to commercial and IP litigation, Mike has more than 31 years of experience litigating and trying other commercial matters, including insurance matters, product liability cases, construction defect disputes, and business torts.

Mike has been a fixture in the insurance subrogation community for 25 years and has successfully handled large property damage and construction cases throughout the country, helping his clients recover over \$100 million in subrogation recoveries.

In addition to Texas and the Southwest, Mike has represented clients in federal and state courts throughout the country, including California, Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, New York, Ohio, and Wisconsin.
